Sold Out Show!

Winger & Mirror Mirror

“WOW!!!!!!! It was just an amazing time,” Doyle (The Soundman) Sinnett told me after the Mirror Mirror/Winger show held this past Friday at The Alrosa Villa in Columbus. “The boys rocked the house. And I was just so proud of them.”

And if you’ve read the messages on the message board at www.mirror2rocks.com you can see that many people who attended the concert felt the same way.

O.K. so I missed out on one of the best concerts of the year (yeah, yeah, I know someone besides Doyle is going to rub this one in). But I couldn’t be prouder of our boys. And from the sound of things, many of you not only made the trip to Columbus, but are willing to follow the band and support them.

“There were several people from the Mid-Ohio Valley who made the trip to Columbus,” said Tracy Allen, lead singer. “It was awesome to see a lot of our fans from here at the show. And many people have been leaving messages on my Myspace page telling me that they will drive there again to support us.”

Mirror Mirror was the opening act for Bad Mojo, Karma 10, and popular 80’s rock band, Winger. The show was sold out, the first time any show at the Alrosa Villa has sold out since 2004!!!! With over 600 people in the Alrosa, it was standing room only.



Mirror Mirror performed the following songs at the show: Shaken Not Stirred, Without Me, Pulse (all Mirror Mirror originals), Boys of Summer, Crazy Bitch, Kid Is Hot Tonight, Livin’ On A Prayer, and Separate Ways.

“Walking out onto the stage and seeing all those people really was the best part. It was awesome,” Tracy said. “And Winger really was great.”

“Kip Winger still has not lost that awesome voice,” Doyle said adding that he got to shake Kip’s hand. “And Bad Mojo and Karma 10 are superb musicians and awesome people just to hang out with. As a matter of fact Karma 10 came to Cadillac Jacks in Columbus on February 10 to support Mirror Mirror. When we got to Columbus for the Winger show, they made us feel like we were right at home.”

Karma 10 will be headlining a show on April 28 at the Alrosa Villa and Mirror Mirror will be one of three opening acts for the band.

In other Mirror Mirror news, the band is currently working on their fourth album, still untitled. The first track, Pulse, was recently performed at the Alrosa Villa, as well as at The Riverside 181 in Marietta and Cadillac Jacks in Columbus. Pulse has received rave reviews from local fans, as well as some new fans acquired in Columbus.

"The fourth album is coming along slowly, but surely," Tracy said. "We are in the process of working on a second song titled Life After Death."

Tracy won't give me a time or date when that track or the new CD will be released, but you can bet since it is Mirror Mirror originals, it will be worth waiting for.

Also, the band will be performing at the Rock It Fest in Clarksburg on June 16. This festival will feature many different bands.

"There will be four major record labels, six different magazines, and we will be on six different radio stations in Clarksburg," Tracy said of the event.

More information on Rock It Fest will be coming in the upcoming weeks.
